Notice inviting Bids/Quotations for supply of Server

1. The Head of Chancery, Embassy of India, Bahrain, invites Bids/Quotations for supply & installation of server as specified in the scope of work.
2. The interested companies, fulfilling the eligibility/qualification criteria given below, may submit their bids/quotations, **in two sealed covers**, to the office of Head of Chancery, Embassy of India, Building No.1090, Road No.2819, Block No.428, Al-Seef District (PABX: (+973) 17 560 360) GoogleMap Location: <https://goo.gl/maps/dNivV1Q1oWv> on or before 1100 hrs of **December 11, 2017**, as per following details:-

Cover 1: Technical bid: The envelope should be prominently superscribed "TECHNICAL BID FOR SUPPLY OF SERVER" and should contain particulars of the bidder (including key personnel and their contact telephone numbers and email addresses) along with:

- a) Bid Security / Earnest Money Deposit of **BHD 100** (Bahraini Dinars One hundred only) in the form of Certified Cheque / Manager's Cheque / Bank Draft of a Registered International Bank in favour of "Embassy of India, Bahrain" and valid for three month.
- b) A brief profile of the company;
- c) Detailed Specifications of the server & its warrantee/support;
- d) A copy of the commercial registration of the company; and
- e) A signed undertaking to confirm fulfilling of eligibility criteria mention in para 4.

The technical bids would be opened at 1130 hrs on December 11, 2017, in the presence of bidders or their representatives who may like to attend the proceedings.

Cover 2: Financial bid: The envelope should be prominently superscribed "FINANCIAL BID FOR SUPPLY OF SERVER " and should contain the financial bids / quotations (valid for three months) indicating amounts in Bahraini Dinars separately for each of the five items mentioned in the scope of work. The Embassy may decide to place the order in respect of any one or more of the items listed in the scope of work.

The date and time of the opening of financial bids would be intimated by email to the technically qualified bidders and the bids would be opened in the presence of qualified bidders or their representatives who may like to attend the proceedings.

3. The Embassy reserves the right to reject a bid without assigning any reason and to restrict the bids to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids are received.
4. **Eligibility of Bidders:**
 - This *Invitation for Bids/Quotations* is applicable to all companies who are registered as a commercial entity with Govt. of Bahrain.
 - The bidder shall conform to the Laws of the Kingdom of Bahrain and should not have been debarred or black-listed for commercial activity including supply / installation / maintenance of electric / electronic equipment by any of the agencies of the Government of the Kingdom of Bahrain.

- The bidder should be the manufacturer or authorized dealer in Bahrain for the supplied equipment.
 - The bidder should have the facility/arrangements (in Bahrain) to repair / maintain the supplied equipment during or after the warrantee period with and without annual maintenance contract.
 - The bidder should be in a position to supply the consumables and other components and spare-parts critical to functioning of the supplied equipment during its estimated life-span.
5. **Scope of Work:** The Financial Bid should indicate separate charges/quotation (valid for minimum three months) for the following:-
- i) Supply of one server as per specifications listed in Annexure “A”;
 - ii) Supply of second server (in case the Embassy decides to purchase two servers of the same specifications as mentioned in Annexure “A”);
 - iii) Charges for physical installation of the server(s) at the Embassy premises and providing drivers (software) support on site;
 - iv) Visit / Service charge, if any, for on-site repair / maintenance of the supplied equipment during the warrantee period – please specify available warrantee period of the supplied equipment; and
 - v) Visit / Service charge for on-site repair / maintenance on of the supplied equipment after the warrantee period without annual maintenance contract.
