## Security Advisory

Keeping in view the upcoming NATO summit in Chicago from May 20 - 22, 2012, there are inputs that Anti Government Elements (AGEs) may carry out strikes in Kabul and elsewhere, to register their presence and to extend their influence to undermine the perception of security.

2. Further, threats of VBIEDs/BBIEDs attacks on high value targets, NATO/ISAF, ANA/ANP convoys, government establishments has increased considerably. The possibility of AGEs targeting Indian nationals and Indian interests in Afghanistan cannot also be ruled out.

3. In view of the above, all Indian nationals residing in Afghanistan are requested to maintain extra vigilance during the coming days. Keeping a safe distance from security convoys and typical government or security-related establishments, checkpoints and barriers is also reiterated, as they continue to remain a target of militants. Unnecessary movements in the city, including in crowded areas like restaurants, markets and Malls may also be avoided. Awareness of the prevailing security scenario via local visual/print media as well as through interaction with fellow colleagues is also suggested.

4. This advisory is being issued to keep the addressees fully aware of the perceived threats for abundant caution and not to create panic, indiscretion or fear.
