Security Advisory

Keeping in view of the 26/11 anniversary and recent inputs indicate possibility of an imminent threat to Indians and Indian interests/establishments from Anti Government Elements (AGEs) in Afghanistan. AGEs may utilize the modus operandi of Vehicle Borne Improvised Explosive Device (VBIED)/Body Borne Improvised Explosive Device (BBIED) followed by armed raids/killing attacks as well as abduction and kidnapping.

2. In view of the above, all Indian nationals are requested to maintain special vigilance during coming days and months and avoid unnecessary movements. They may also keep themselves informed about the prevailing security scenario through local visual/print media and through interaction with fellow colleagues. They are advised to stay in safer places, which have strong peripheral security and strict access control measures and move in pairs/groups so that, in case of any eventuality, a companion can contact the concerned authorities. In order to avoid forming a fixed pattern of movement, they are advised to constantly change their travel routes and timings.

3. This advisory is being issued only to make the addressees aware of the perceived threats and not to create panic or fear.
