## **SECURITY ADVISORY**

Fresh inputs indicate heightened threat perception in respect of areas in and around Kabul especially Indian facilities, concentrations and construction sites. All Indians should, therefore, maintain extra alert.

- 2. Inputs further reveal that several suicide bombers have sneaked into Kabul to attack against Indian interests, besides Afghan National Security Force (ANSF) and International Security Assistance Forces (ISAF).
- 3. All Indian nationals in Afghanistan are advised to exercise utmost caution and restrict avoidable movements to the barest minimum. They are further advised to take utmost precautions while traveling in and around Kabul. Movements should be kept unpredictable, information about it restricted and the route variable. In case of movement or travel, keep a partner or organization head or security informed of it. While traveling, maintain safe distance from vehicles or convoys of the Afghan National Security Forces (ANSF), North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) and International Security Assistance Forces (ISAF).
