SECURITY ADVISORY

In Afghanistan, the 'Kabul Conference' is being held on July 20, 2010 in which many foreign dignitaries are coming to attend this Conference. From the period from July 19 to 21, 2010, the security scenario in the area is going to be heightened.

2. The security arrangements adopted by the Afghan authorities for this day will begin from mid-night of July 18 and onwards. With these arrangements, road movements in and around Kabul will be affected by barricading and closures of those roads which are leading to Kabul City in general and particularly the roads leading to the Conference Venue i.e. Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Shah Mohammad Ghazi Road, Kabul. The Afghan National Security Force (ANSF) will be manning extra check points/road block throughout the City.

3. The Public Affairs Wing of Embassy of India, Kabul, from time to time, conveys the Security Advisories to the Indians residing in Afghanistan to follow the utmost security precautions.

4. As advised earlier, the security situation in Afghanistan is still fragile and in view of continuing inputs regarding threat, all Indians staying in Kabul and other parts of Afghanistan are requested to maintain extra vigil. While traveling, maintain safe distance from vehicles or convoys of the Afghan National Security Forces (ANSF), North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) and International Security Assistance Forces (ISAF), as these continue to remain primary targets of militants. It is requested that unnecessary movement to government buildings, public places such as markets and restaurants, may please be curtailed/avoided. Indians are also requested to keep themselves aware about the security scenario in the country through local visual/print media as well as through interaction with their fellow colleagues in various organizations.
