Supreme Court of Afghanistan has been quoted on local television news that anyone eating, drinking or smoking in public during Ramadan will be arrested. This includes those with exemptions from fasting (people travelling, the sick and nursing mothers) who are expected to eat and drink in private.

2. All the Indians those who are residing in Afghanistan are advised to abide by strictly follow the rules of Afghanistan Government by avoiding eating, drinking or smoking in public during day light hours, including while in vehicles.
