• Suicide attack in Kabul on April 6, 2007

Details

On April 6, 2007, a suicide bomber exploded an explosive - laden Taxi on the Dar-ul-Aman road near the Afghan Parliament at 0800 hours. In the explosion, 6 persons were killed including police personnel and many others injured. Taliban has taken responsibility for the attack and warned of more suicide attacks in the near future in Afghanistan.

- 2. In view of an overall increase in militant activity in the past few weeks, all Indian nationals in Afghanistan are cautioned to remain extra vigilant at all times and avoid unnecessary exposure/movement during road journeys for their own safety and security. It is once again reiterated that they must maintain safe distance from Military/Police/NATO/CF convoys as they have continued to remain primary targets of militants. Indians are also requested to keep themselves aware about the security scenario in the country through local print/visual media.
- 3. The Embassy of India is grateful to all Indians who have responded positively to our request of registering themselves in the past few weeks. It is hoped that you would also inform and persuade other Indians to register themselves with the Embassy so that they also could be on our mailing list for security alerts and advisories.
