Two MOUs on High Impact Community Development Projects signed with Uzbekistan

Under the framework of the strong development partnership between India and Uzbekistan, two projects identified as High Impact Community Development Projects were finalised for implementation and MOUs on them were signed in Tashkent on 11 December 2021. The two projects are "Creation and Equipment of a New Reference Laboratory in the Republican Scientific Specialized Allergological Center through The Republican Scientific Specialized Allergological Center of Uzbekistan of the Republic of Uzbekistan and Equipping 150 Secondary Schools in Syrdarya Region with Computers through the Ministry of Public Education of the Republic of Uzbekistan" which will be implemented at the cost of about USD 2.5 Million under India's grant assistance. The MOUs were signed at the Ministry of Investment and Foreign Trade of the Republic of Uzbekistan by Ambassador of India, H.E. Mr. Manish Prabhat, Deputy Minister H. E. Mr. Laziz Kudratov and the representatives of the Republican Scientific Specialised Allergological Center and the Ministry of Public Education, the concerned implementing agencies.

It may be recalled that the Memorandum of Understanding on the High Impact Community Development Projects between India and Uzbekistan was signed during the Virtual Summit held between Prime Minister of India H.E. Mr. Narendra Modi and President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, H.E. Mr. Shavkat Mirziyoyev on 11 December 2020.
