Embassy of India, Ashgabat organized a meeting between businessmen from India and Turkmenistan engaged in the textile, leather and cotton sectors through videoconferencing on November 26, 2020. The event was held in association with the Indian Merchant Chamber (IMC), India and Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Turkmenistan and Union of Industrialists and Entrepreneurs of Turkmenistan (UIET).

The event began with the welcome address by the Chairman of Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Turkmenistan Mr. Dovletgeldi Rejepov, followed by speech by Ambassador Dr. Vidhu P. Nair in which he highlighted the immense potential for enhancing trade in the textile, leather, and cotton sectors between the two sides, emphasizing India's capability and expertise in these fields. The Co-Chairman - International Business Committee of IMC, Mr. Saurabh Shah also spoke on the occasion.

This was followed by presentations by firms from India and Turkmenistan on different products. More than 40 businesspersons participated in the videoconference, along with representatives of Ministry of Textile, Ministry of Trade and Foreign Economic relations of Turkmenistan. They discussed the import and export of textiles, leather and cotton products. Issues pertaining to logistics and regulations also featured in the discussions.
