## REVISED TRAVEL ADVISORY

The government of the Kingdom of Bahrain has announced following revised International arrival procedures **w.e.f. 24 May 2021** for passengers coming from India and some other countries:

1. *Entry into Bahrain will be restricted to Bahraini citizens; and **holders of Bahraini residency visa only.***
2. *All Passengers from India (above 6 years of age) must carry negative RT-PCR test report with a QR code conducted within 48 hours before their departure.*
3. *All Passengers from India (above 6 years of age) must undergo PCR testing (at their own cost) upon arrival and test again on 10th day of their arrival.*
4. *They have to undergo quarantine for a period of 10 days at a government designated hotel licensed by National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA) or at their Residence.*

**In order to avoid unnecessary inconvenience to the Indian passengers arriving at Bahrain International Airport, it is advised that all passengers coming from India must be holding Bahraini Residence Visas and should carry RT-PCR negative test reports with valid QR code and they should invariably verify the QR code by scanning the same before undertaking their travel to Bahrain. They should also carry proof of reservation in their name for a designated quarantine facility OR proof of a residence, either owned or leased by the passenger or an immediate family member before boarding the flight.**
