

Slots allotted to Bahrain

Under the Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation (ITEC) Program 2015-16, Government of India provided five slots to Bahrain for medium and long term training during the period April, 2015 –March, 2016 for upgrading administrative and technical skills of their personnel. All the five slots have been filled and mid-term review is under consideration of the Ministry of External Affairs.
