Ministry of Home Affairs has explained revised instruction/guidelines on "Re-issuance of OCI cards due to Issuance of new foreign passports to OCI cardholders".

- 2. The Salient points are as follows:
- (i) Mandatory requirement of re-issuance of an OCI card **each time** a new passport is issued to a foreigner upto **20 years of age** and **once** after completing **50 years of age** is **dispensed** with.
- (ii) OCI cardholder is required to get the OCI card re-issued only <u>once</u> when a new passport is issued after completing 20 years of age.
- (iii) OCI cardholder is required to **upload ONLINE** a copy of the **new passport and a latest photo** <u>each time</u> a new passport is issued upto 20 years of age and <u>once</u> after completing 50 years of age. The uploading of these documents may be done within <u>three</u> <u>months</u> of receipt of the new passport. The service will be provided on **Gratis** basis.
- (iv) Foreign Spouse of an Indian Citizen or spouse of foreign origin of an OCI cardholder are required to upload a copy of the **new passport and also a latest photo ONLINE** each time a new passport is issued along with a declaration on subsisting of marriage, copy of the Indian passport of the Indian spouse/passport & OCI card of the OCI cardholder spouse.
