Security Advisory

A credible threat input has been received suggesting a possible attack on Indian Embassy properties and on Indians in general in the near future. As per the information received, some anti-Indian agents are attempting to map the locations of Indians working in Kabul, their place of stay, office address, etc. Such agents could even approach to Indians stationed in Kabul in the guise of security personnel and ask them for their identity cards, home and office address, etc. on the pretext of enhancing their security. They may even produce ID Cards, possibly forged, of one or the other Government security agency.

- 2. Keeping this in mind, all Indian nationals in Kabul are advised to be extra vigilant in general and in particular if individuals claiming to be representatives of Government security agencies approach them for personal details. Should any Indian national encounter such an incident, they should immediately inform the Indian Embassy at the earliest to cross-check or take up the matter with the concerned relevant authorities.
- 3. Another input suggests that targeting of Indian interests and nationals by AGEs to time with the upcoming August 15 Independence Day may also be expected. Though local security authorities are themselves alert to this possibility, extra vigilance on this count is also strongly advised over the coming days.
- 4. This advisory is being issued to keep the addressees conscious of security threats in the interest of abundant caution and not over-react in the form of panic, fear or indiscretion vis-a-vis the media.
