SECURITY ADVISORY

In Afghanistan, the Mujahideen Day is being commemorated on April 28, 2010. From the period from April 27 to 29, 2010, the security scenario in the area is going to be heightened.

2. The security measures adopted by the Government for this day will begin from mid-night of April 27 and onwards. With these arrangements, road movements inside and around Kabul will be affected by road closures particularly of those roads which are leading to Kabul City. Afghan National Security Force (ANSF) will be manning extra check points/road block throughout the City.

3. Meanwhile, there is a report of two rockets fired by the Anti Government Elements in Kabul on April 27 from Police District-8 and impacted near the stadium apparently hitting a wall. Another rocket hit in Police District-16 in the Macaryoun Section.

4. In view of continuing inputs regarding threat, all Indians staying in Kabul and other parts of Afghanistan are requested to maintain extra vigilance. It is also requested that unnecessary movement to government buildings, public places such as bazaars and restaurants, may please be curtailed/avoided.
