SECURITY ADVISORY

As you are aware, Afghanistan is going to experience the parliamentary elections to be held on September 18, 2010 to elect representatives to Lower House (Wolesi Jirga) of Parliament. The threat perception is heightened during the coming days.

- 2. Further, inputs received from various channels revealed that Anti Government Elements may try to disrupt the election process by targeting Government installations or electorates to disrupt the election process.
- 3. In view of continuing fragile security scenario, all Indians staying in Kabul and other parts of Afghanistan are advised to maintain extra vigilance during coming days. It is also advised that unnecessary movement to Government buildings, public places such as bazaars and restaurants, may please be avoided or keep it to the bare minimum. Avoid coming in the proximity of the convoys of Army and Police. Also avoid going near the building where polling booths are located. Awareness of the prevailing security scenario via local visual/print media as well as through interaction with fellow colleagues is also suggested.
