SECURITY ADVISORY

• **Threat of possible Suicide Attacks in Kabul City**

Details

This is in continuation of our earlier Security Advisories regarding continuous threat of possible suicide attacks including threat of abductions in Kabul city.

2. Fresh information indicates that two suicide bombers are reportedly planning to conduct suicide attacks using a fuel tanker packed with explosives. Likely targets could be the Hotel Kabul Serena and the Da Afghanistan Bank.

3. Another suicide bomber may use a Toyota Corolla Car with Registration No. 52858 KB as VBIED to carry out attack between the Abdul Haq Circle and Kabul International Airport.

4. It is also learnt that a Toyota Corolla Car with Registration No. SH-3112-KB rigged with explosives has reportedly been tasked to carry out a suicide attack against high profile targets on the road between Sadarat Chowk–Iranian Embassy–Wazir Akbar Khan and Kabul International Airport.

5. In view of the above information, the Embassy of India, Kabul advises all Indian nationals residing in Kabul city as well as in other parts of Afghanistan to remain extra vigilant during their road movements. It is also reiterated that in case a road journey is to be performed, adequate security protection in the convoy or in the vehicle should be carried. Unnecessary movement in public places such as restaurants bazaars/crowded areas may please be curtailed. It is reiterated to constantly change your route/timings within the city so as to not form a pattern of movement. Keeping a safe distance from International Military/ANA/ANP convoys is again advised, as they continue to be a target of militants.
