• Threat of suicide attacks in Kabul City

Details

This is in continuation of our earlier Security Advisories regarding continuous threat of possible suicide attacks in Kabul city.

- 2. Fresh information suggests that 21 suicide bombers have reportedly entered in Kabul city to carryout attacks on high profile targets in different parts of the city including Embassies, Masood Circle, Wazir Akbar Khan area, Kabul International Airport and on GoA Security Agency offices. Further, two more suicide bombers have arrived at Uzbin village of Surobi District in Kabul province from across the border to target International Military and Afghan National Security Forces in the area.
- 3. In view of continuing grave threat inputs, there is a possibility of more suicide attacks being planned in Kabul city. All Indians staying in Kabul city and other parts of Afghanistan are requested to remain extra vigilant during their movements in the city. Avoid government buildings, public places such as bazaars, restaurants, crowded areas and constantly change your route/timings within the city so as to not form a pattern of movement. Keeping a safe distance from International Military/ANA/ANP convoys is again reiterated, as they continue to be a target of militants.
