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- **A suicide car bomber hit a convoy of Security contractors in Kabul**
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Details

Today, on June 28, 2007, a suicide car bomber hit a security contractor's convoy in eastern Kabul. In the blast one American and one Nepalese were killed. Three other American contractors and two Afghan civilians were injured in the attack. Two of the contractors' vehicles caught fire after the explosion. The occupants of one of the vehicle that was slightly damaged fired into the air to prevent civilians from approaching the site.

2. As advised from time to time, in view of an overall increase in the militant activities in the form of IED, RCIED and suicide attacks, all Indian nationals in Afghanistan are once again advised to remain extra vigilant at all times and avoid unnecessary exposure/movement during road journeys for their own safety and security. It is also reiterated that they must maintain a safe distance from Afghan Military and Police/NATO/CF convoys as these continue to remain primary targets of militants. Indians are also requested to keep themselves aware about the security scenario in the country through local visual/print media as well as through interaction with their fellow colleagues in various organizations. To ensure your safety and security a fixed pattern of movement in the city may also be avoided.
