Highlights

- Rocket attack in Kabul
- Suicide attack on Jalalabad Road in Kabul

Details:

On August 24, 200 late evening at about 1045 hours, a rocket hit Wazir Akbar Khan Hospital, Kabul but did not cause any damage or casualties. In the attack, a water tank in the hospital was damaged. According to the local police, the rocket was fired from Pul e Charkhi area in the east of the city.

- 2. On August 25, 200 around 1630 hours, a Vehicle borne suicide bomber blew himself near a convoy of foreign military forces in Paktiakot area in the eastern part of the city on the Jalalabad road. In the explosion, no damage was caused either to the military personnel or to their vehicles. However, 4 civilians were injured in the explosion and were later shifted to hospital for treatment.
- 3. In view of the heightened militant activity in Kabul, all Indians are advised to keep themselves aware of the latest news through local print and visual media relating to the security situation. Further, it would be prudent to curtail unnecessary movement by road. You would be well advised to maintain safe distance from International Security Forces/ANA/Police convoys, which have continued to remain prime targets of militants.
