• Possible suicide attack against ANA bus

<u>Details</u>

An information indicates that there exists a threat of possible suicide attack against Afghan National Army (ANA) bus/convoy in Kabul city on November 13 and 14, 2007.

2. In view of the threat, all Indian nationals in Kabul are advised to keep a safe distance from all Afghan National Army/Police Buses/convoys, during their movement in the city in next couple of days.

3. Further, Indian nationals are also advised to remain extra vigilant at all times for their own safety and security. Once again, it is reiterated that a safe distance must be maintained from Afghan Military and Police/NATO/CF convoys/buses as these continue to remain primary targets of militants. Indians are also requested to keep themselves aware about the security scenario in the country through local visual/print media as well as through interaction with their fellow colleagues in various organizations. To ensure your own safety and security a fixed pattern of movement in the city may also be avoided.
