• Suicide attack on the Kabul International Airport road

<u>Details</u>

Today, on December 4, 2007 at around 0815 hours, a suicide VBIED targeted a two vehicle NATO's ISAF convoy near Khairkhana on the Airport road in Kabul. As per available information, in the explosion 10 Afghans, who were in a minibus near the blast site, were wounded. In the explosion, the attacker's car was completely destroyed and three private vehicles including the minibus were also damaged.

2. As advised from time to time, in view of increased militant activities of all kinds in Kabul city, all Indian nationals in Kabul and Afghanistan are advised to remain extra vigilant at all times for their own safety and security. It is also reiterated that a safe distance must be maintained from Afghan Military and Police/NATO/CF convoys/ buses as these continue to remain primary targets of militants. Indians are also requested to keep themselves aware about the security scenario in the country through local visual/print media as well as through interaction with their fellow colleagues in various organizations. To ensure your safety and security a fixed pattern of movement in the city may also be avoided.
