NOTICE FOR STUDENTS APPLYING FOR ICCR SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME TO STUDY IN INDIA

The following important advisory maybe followed by the students applying for ICCR Scholarship to study in India:

1. Students have to satisfy themselves about the course chosen and the confirmation given by the universities. Admission is <u>provisional</u> till the universities satisfy themselves of the authenticity of requisite documents from the students.

2. If on arrival in India, it is found that the student does not possess the required original documents on the basis of copies of which the admission has been finalised, the students will themselves be responsible for the consequences including denial of admission by the universities and shall be sent back. ICCR will not bear the cost on such student's return airfare to Kabul.

3. The students arriving in India to join the university after their admission should bring the <u>following documents</u>:

- (i) Original documents relating to their qualifications for verification by the respective college/University.
- (ii) English Translation of the documents in original.
- (iii) Certified copy of the syllabus of the last qualifying examination.
- (iv) Valid passport with appropriate visa. Students visa for undergraduate/post graduate and research visa for Ph.D students.

4. The students should complete the following Pre-departure formalities before leaving to join the universities in India:

- (i) While booking tickets students may ensure that there is sufficient gap between the timings of the connecting flights from Delhi to the location of the university (5-6 hrs) so that there is enough time to complete the transit formalities, particularly in view of the Covid-19 induced restrictions.
- (ii) There may be difference of baggage allowance in domestic and international flight. Students may ensure to carry the baggage equivalent to the limit of the lower category (domestic air ticket free check in allowance.)

- (iii) On purchase of ticket student should submit the ticket to the Education Wing, Embassy of India in Kabul for uploading their travel details on the A2A portal to enable ICCR's Regional Office to make necessary arrangements in India.
- (iv) Students may get themselves registered with Foreign Regional Registration Office within a period of 14 day of arrival in India.
- (v) Students may procure medical insurance policy of a value of Rs. Five lakhs. Medical insurance is compulsory for the students at their cost. Students may buy medical insurance in Afghanistan or on their arrival in India.
