Security Advisory

Unrest, including violence, related to the election is expected. This comes on top of Taliban's spring offensive and a series of attacks in and around Kabul, besides other provinces all contributing to deterioration of the overall security environment. This makes for a volatile mixture, and anti-government elements may think of taking advantage of the situation. We have also seen general security threats against Indian interests including Indian citizens living and working in Afghanistan.

Thus Embassy of India calls on all Indian nationals to remain vigilant and watchful and avoid unnecessary public exposure. Avoid areas with demonstrations or other tensions, and remain in touch with your colleagues and the Embassy for information and advise. Please also ensure that your travel documents (Passport & Visa) remain updated/valid at all times.
