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Aim & Objective

In this training programme participants would be given a comprehensive orientation of the SDGs to help them comprehend the essence and inter-connects of sustainable development in their development plan in a holistic manner. The emphasis would be to make the participants understand the three dimensions social, economic and environmental along with technical features of the Agenda 2030 and their application in national contexts. The training programme seeks to expose the participants to the nuances of the sustainability debate. Programme would focus on local challenges and opportunities for implementation of SDGs in sub-national strategies, regional context and their integration globally.

The programme emphasises on specialised areas like formulation of local plans, creating knowledge and information base (data and indicators) and tools for assessment. The programme would also encourage online interaction among participants as groups about issues and the way forward for implementing the SDGs by 2030.

Mode of Evaluation

Each participant is expected to make an online power point presentation on a subject relevant to the programme, an assessment would be made on this basis.
