It was founded in the year 2016 with the active support from Government of Maharashtra. The Chief Minister of Maharashtra is the Chief Patron of this platform. It is also supported by University Grants Commission (UGC), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) (Ministry of HRD), Association of Indian University (AIU) and the UNESCO Chair of Human rights, Democracy, Peace & Tolerance, Pune.
