Reception of 71st Republic Day of India held by the Embassy of India in Tashkent

The 71st Republic Day of India Reception was held on 24 January 2020 at Hotel Hyatt Regency in Tashkent. Prime Minister of the Republic of Uzbekistan H.E. Mr. Abdulla Aripov was the Chief Guest on the occasion. Mayor of Tashkent city H.E. Mr. Jahongir Artikhojaev, Deputy Foreign Minister H. E. Mr. Dilshod Akhatov and Chairman of Uzbek Chamber of Commerce and Industry H.E. Mr. Adkham Ikramov also attended the reception.
