



India will help Uzbekistan train specialists for Afghanistan

In Delhi, negotiations were held on the peaceful settlement of the Afghan crisis between the Special Representative of the President of Uzbekistan Ismatulla Irgashev and Deputy Advisor to the Prime Minister of India on National Security Pankaj Sarana. The parties discussed issues of a peaceful settlement of the military-political conflict in Afghanistan, as well as the implementation of various projects in this country.

One of the central issues during the meeting was the training of personnel for Afghanistan at the educational center for the training of Afghans in Termez.

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India expressed its readiness to organize on the basis of this center courses in the specialties that are most in demand in Afghanistan.

Earlier, Uzbekistan and India agreed to jointly combat transnational organized crime and terrorism.
